We are racing against time to get into the foreign field. God has given us an open door in the Philippines and Communist China. I have 100 Filipino Bible college students *right now*, and the organization established and running in the Philippines to train hundreds more. We placed five missionaries in Communist China last year. *Right now* we have open doors into China that are unbelievable. We are not novices in the ministry. I spent almost 30 years pastoring in the USA. By the grace of God we built a solid ministry. We have references as to our integrity and character.

God thrust my wife and me into this harvest field. We have sold out and left a life of ease and comfort to get the gospel to a lost world. No man lives to himself. All of us need others to help. *Without faithful prayer and generous givers when I was a pastor, no work would have been done. Mission work is no different.*

Will you become our partners in this great work? Pray for us. That is the greatest need. Next, if God has blessed you with finances, will you help by becoming a regular monthly supporter?

You and I have a debt that is due (Romans 1:14). Help our feet run to pay that debt while we still have the opportunity!

During the meantime, souls go out into eternity in those fields that never heard the name of Jesus one time.

(This article was written in 1993. We did get to the Philippines. Eight years later, over 22,500 souls have been saved and 31 churches are established. During this time EOTEM was started. We did not seek to begin a mission board but God gave us that responsibility. Our missionaries now work in several countries. We helped place 28 missionaries in China. This year we begin a coordinated effort to begin Bible training among Chinese converts. The Philippine work continues under trained national leadership. If we can do something for Jesus Christ in this world, anyone can. Why not join us?)
